- Summary Operations**
- 1) Progressive extraction of mineral will take place in a series of 5 phases, followed by the sequential restoration of available extracted land through both importation and placement of inert material, and utilising on-site soils to create final soil profiles.
 - 2) Due to the phased nature of extraction and subsequent restoration of individual phasing compartments, the exposed area of extraction will be minimised.
 - 3) All materials will be processed at the Poyle Quarry Plant Site to the east of the Application Site
 - 4) Material will be transported to the Plant Site via a new access track, utilising the existing Bailey Bridge over the Colne Brook
 - 5) A new access road is proposed, linking the Poyle Quarry Plant Site to Poyle Road to the east - subject to a separate planning application to Slough Borough Council
 - 6) All land within the Site will be managed under an agricultural regime and enhanced to promote habitat creation

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
